

**HIXON PARISH MEETING HELD ON
Tuesday 15th May 2018**

1. Minutes of the last Parish Meeting were agreed by the Council and signed by the Chairman on June 20th 2017.

Matters Arising

2. A presentation was given by Cllr. Kelly on Speedwatch: Currently doing 2 sessions per month, 4 new people are being trained. Percentage of vehicles found speeding varies from 2 to 14. Most of the recent speeding vehicles have between 35mph and 45+ mph, one was >45mph. 1 person reported as using a mobile phone. 6 HGVs were noted as driving in to village on the most recent occasion, some almost certainly should not have been. The main sites checked are New Road, Church Lane and Church Road, there are also 2 sites on High Street/Legge Lane. An application has been made to have permanent Speedwatch signage installed.

The Chair gave a powerpoint presentation encompassing the main issues and achievements of 2017-2018 and included the financial (Clerk's) report:

- Neighbourhood Plan and planning applications
- Speedwatch
- Babbage Building
- Keep Hixon Clean campaign
- Dog Poo Campaign
- Highway safety improvements Church Lane

3. The receipts and expenditure for 2017 - 2018 were presented, reviewing the main sources of income and of expenditure. There were no major projects during 2017-2018. The Parish Council had £2008 more in the bank at the end of 2017-2018 than it had at the start of 2017-2018.
